Clifford Eugene Rinck 82, of rural Johnson County, MO passed away Saturday, December 12, 2020 at Saint Luke's East Hospital in Lee's Summit, MO. Clifford was born on March 15, 1938 in Willow Springs, MO the son of Claude and Ella Rinck. Clifford was a graduate of Fort Osage High School. He was baptized at Mount Olivet Baptist Church in Levasy, MO where he was a member. Clifford was a veteran of the United States Air Force. Primarily stationed in Germany, he proudly served his country for 4 years from 1957 to 1961. On September 26, 1962, Clifford started work at Western Electric in Lee's Summit, MO retiring after 34 years and 1 day on September 27, 1996. He married Judy Mae Stansberry in Holden, MO at the Methodist Church on July 6, 1969. They celebrated their 50th Wedding Anniversary in 2019. Clifford was a deeply committed Christian and very focused on lifelong learning.

Clifford was preceded in death by his parents Claude and Ella Rinck; two sisters, Lorena Mae Rinck and Jean Lewis.
