Dennis S. Chesnut, 78 of Lone Jack, Missouri met his Lord and Savior on Saturday, December 2, 2023, at Kindred Hospital Northland in Kansas City, Missouri.

He was born Thursday, October 4, 1945 in Olney, Illinois, to the late Morton Scott "Scotty" Chesnut and the late Dorothy (Fallert) Chesnut. Denny was a graduate of Newton Illinois High School - class of 1963. He then earned his Bachelors degree at Southern Illinois University and then earned his Masters degree at Midwestern Baptist Theological Seminary in Kansas City.

In June of 1967 he married Carolyn (Dean) Chesnut and soon after enlisted in the United States Army serving his country proudly during the Vietnam War. Denny pastored six different churches in his 39 years of service; he loved every one of his congregations dearly. He invested time in people and truly loved just sitting and visiting with them.
