Glenn and Deloris enjoyed traveling and researching their genealogy. Glenn was a pretty quiet man who kept mainly to himself. Glenn was quite content and just enjoyed living life to the fullest. Glenn served on the Bear Creek Cemetery Association and was a

lifelong resident and friend of the Holden community. Glenn will be missed by all those who knew his loving and caring personality.

Surviving his passing are his niece and nephews. Glenn is preceded in death by his parents; Francis Thomason and Dorothy (Whiteman) Thomason, his wife; Deloris (Aldridge) Thomason and his son; Brian Thomason.
