Eight days after coming into the world, Jaxon Matthew Apollo Dale passed away peacefully in his parents' arms at Overland Park Regional Medical Center, Kansas. During that fleeting time, he touched many lives and was loved by all who met him. Jaxon had an army of friends, family and loved ones lifting him up continually to the Lord in prayer for peace and healing!

Born on March 30 without a heartbeat, the staff at St. Luke's East Hospital resuscitated him and he was transported to the NICU at Overland Park Regional Medical Center. Jaxon was known for his luscious brown locks of hair, weighed 8 lb. 5 oz., and went by "Super Jax" because of his fighting spirit. His nurses and support staff, especially at Overland Park showered him in compassion and care as if he were their own and helped him to feel safe and loved around the clock.

Jaxon made lasting memories with his family during his too-brief time here, including early morning "birth time" celebrations and serenades with his Mom, an all-night guys night with his Dad, getting to meet his Grandpa and Grandma Dale and Aunt Caitlin, peeing on his Dad during a sponge bath, a night resting between his parents' loving arms, and many hours of singing and praying and reading God's Word while being held.

On April 7, Jaxon's parents surrendered him into the arms of Jesus for complete healing. Jaxon didn't experience any pain or suffering in this life and is now in Heaven with Jesus in perfect joy, love and peace. Jaxon's family is already looking forward to seeing him in Heaven and getting to know him as God created him to be!
