Joanne C. Rodgers, age 91, of Holden, Missouri, passed away peacefully at St. Luke's East Hospital in Lee's Summit, Missouri surrounded by her beloved family on March 24, 2019.

Joanne was born in Kansas City, Missouri on January 11, 1928 to William H. and Edna (Smith) Coleman. She lived in the Holden area most of her life.
