John Alten Roberson, Holden, Missouri, died Sunday, January 25, 2015, at John Knox Village, in Lee's Summit, Missouri. He was born March 20, 1938 in Beach Grove, Arkansas the son of Jess Roberson and Aris (Copeland) Roberson and attended school in Lanton, MO near West Plains MO. He lived in the Holden area since 1972. John was an autoworker at the General Motors Leeds plant in Kansas City, Missouri until it closed. He then transferred to the GM factory in Shreveport, LA, where he retired August 1993.
