LeRoy Oren VanGilder, 86, of Garden City, Missouri passed away peacefully at his home on Friday, July 22, 2022, surrounded by his loved ones. LeRoy attended Scaley Bark grade school, from there going to and graduating from Holden High School in 1953. His love of singing and playing guitar would then carry over to the campsite where he'd sit and sing and play music with friends from all around the country. For over 30 years they wintered in Texas, early on settling in fishing camps and fishing the Rio Grande, on the boat they hauled from Missouri. After a few years of fishing, they gave that up for more social activities. He found a new love of line dancing, singing karaoke and of course playing on his guitar. While in Texas he was a member of the Lake Front Church in Zapata, and even

became a board member. He attended Rose Hill Baptist Church when he was home and served on the Cemetery Board in his free time. LeRoy will be deeply missed by everyone, especially his family.
