

Marty Scott Junkins

April 4, 1960 - September 12, 2023

Marty “Bubba” Scott Junkins, 63 of Holden, MO passed away unexpectedly on Tuesday September 12, 2023, at St Luke’s East Hospital in Lee’s Summit, MO. He was born Tuesday, April 4, 1960, in Oskaloosa, IA to Gary and Marilyn (Mueller) Junkins. Bubba as he was affectionately known, graduated from Oskaloosa High School and then attended the University of Northern Iowa.

Marty moved to Missouri and co-owned and operated Sharp’s Restaurant in Kansas City for over 20 years. He developed a large community of close friends that remain so to this day. He continued his love of cooking, by grilling, smoking meat, and baking bread up until his passing.

horse, Flash, who he considered his puppy dog. Marty was special to many people and will be missed deeply.

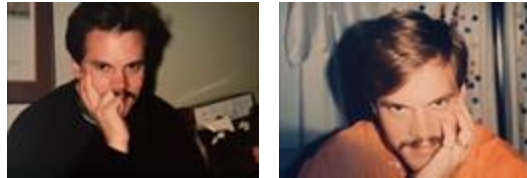
