Mendy Kay Hammons, age of 69 of Holden, Missouri passed away peacefully surrounded by her loved ones on Wednesday August 27, 2025, at St. Luke's East Hospital in Lee's Summit, Missouri. Mendy was born on Sunday, January 01, 1956, in St. Louis, Missouri, to Jerome "Jerry" Rapp and Frances (McKinney) Rapp.

Family was very important to her; she cherished spending time with her parents and loved her time with her children and grandchildren. Her dog Jake was very important too and a huge part of their family. Mendy loved gardening and taking care of her flower beds. Her hobbies included collecting antiques, crafting, cooking and baking. Mendy had a way of being able to make friends with everyone. She was a very social person and loved visiting and having conversations with people. She was involved in several different groups, Bible Study, Garden Club, Women's Club in Lexington to name a few. She volunteered and participated in local government zoning boards and other boards as well. Mendy's beautiful smile and her loving spirit will be missed by those who loved and knew her.
