Micah Helaman Selman was born June 30, 1979 in Hiawatha, Kansas, the eldest son of Larry Selman and Theresa Armstrong Selman Moody. His birth was a miraculous gift since his mother had been told she was unable to have children. Despite serious health problems beginning in early childhood, he was a natural athlete and excelled at baseball and golf. In 1998 Micah moved to Kingsville from the Horton Kansas area. Here he met and married Debi Greer and they were blessed with one daughter, Mariah Amaris.

Micah made friends easily everywhere he went. He was also gifted at working with the sick and afflicted, received training as a CMT, and became a caregiver for mentally and physically disabled men. Micah's own health problems worsened overtime and eventually forced him to stop working. On May 4, 2018 Micah passed peacefully in his sleep, to reunite with his loved ones who awaited him in our everlasting home. He was of Lakota and Cherokee heritage, and a member of the Reorganized Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints.

He is survived by his daughter, Mariah Selman, Garden City, Missouri; his brother, Daniel Selman and wife Susanna of Olathe, Kansas; his step-father, John Moody of the home; and the extended family.

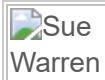
