He enjoyed dancing and doing the moves to the song “The Wheels on the Bus”, listening to music and playing with trucks, cars, and tractors. Noah always had the most fun playing with his two best playmates Olivia and James.

Noah spent many months at Children’s Mercy Hospital where his favorite thing was riding laps upon laps around 4 Henson, being pulled by whoever was willing. He also enjoyed road trips to Topeka to spend time there with his family.

Noah flew to Seattle, Washington twice and participated in T-Cell Therapy Trials. He was the first and only pediatric patient to participate in the trials. Although it did not cure Noah, it did extend his life and the days he had with his family. Noah's Family's hope is that his life and participation in the trials will help others on the same journey and contribute to finding a cure for leukemia one day soon.

Though Noah had a short life, it was a life full of love from his family, his loving community, and friends who fought right alongside him every step of the way.
