



Norman Wilbur Maloney

January 1, 1927 - February 15, 2020

Norman Wilbur Maloney, 93, formerly of Lee's Summit MO, passed away Saturday, Feb. 15, 2020, at the Missouri Veterans Home in Warrensburg MO, where he had lived for 3 years.

He was born January 1, 1927, in Elm MO, the son of Jess Maloney and Bonnie Beall Maloney. Norman graduated from Holden High School in 1945, then joined the United States Army where he served honorably from June 1945 to December 1946. He married Billie Marie Shippy on February 12, 1949. He farmed in Elm, drove a Skelly Oil truck then moved to Lee's Summit, working in Quality Control for Western Electric 22 years before retiring. During those years he also became a realtor and broker of Norm Maloney Realty. Norman was a member of the Kingsville Seventh Day Adventist Church, the Board of Realtors, the Warrensburg Masonic Lodge #265 and the Lee's Summit Masonic Lodge #263.
