



## Rick Wayne McQueary

February 26, 1954 - April 14, 2026

Richard “Rick” Wayne McQueary, age 72, of Holden, Missouri, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, April 14, 2026, at Lee’s Summit Medical Center, surrounded by his loving family.

Rick was born on Friday, February 26, 1954, in Peoria, Illinois, the son of Shelva and Delia (Hildebrand) McQueary. He grew up in Peoria and graduated from Dunlap High School. Following graduation, Rick proudly served his country in the United States Air Force, attaining the rank of Sergeant and serving for four years.

While stationed at Whiteman Air Force Base in Knob Noster, Missouri, Rick met the love of his life, Marcia. The couple was united in marriage on May 30, 1976, in Peoria, Illinois. They made their home there for three years, during which time Rick worked for Caterpillar Inc.
