Robert Paul Hirner Jr., 79, passed away Monday, September 23, 2024, at his home in Warrensburg, Missouri. Bob, as he was known by, was born May 02, 1945, in Hannibal, Missouri to the late Robert P. Hirner and Clarine (Hicks) Hirner.

Bob graduated from Hannibal High School in Hannibal, Mo. and attended Hannibal-LaGrange College.

He served in the United States Army in Vietnam from 1969-1970.
