Rodney Wayne "Rod" Hurt, 63, of Holden, Missouri passed away Saturday, March 27, 2021. Rod was born on March 5, 1958 in Warrensburg, MO the son of John Sidney Hurt and Marilyn Joyce (Giersch) Hurt. Rod lived his entire life in Holden. He was a member of the Holden High School Graduating Class of 1976.
