Wanita Faye Lyons (Shepherd), 85 of Melbourne, Florida formerly of Holden, MO passed away on Thursday, October 14, 2021, at Vitas Hospice in Melbourne, Florida.

She was born Sunday, October 27, 1935, in Mt. Zion, Missouri, and was the daughter of the late Leander Shepherd and the late Annis (Bray) Shepherd. She was the wife of the late Bill Lyons.
